I. <u>CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL</u>

Chair Sirmans called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence. Chair Sirmans called roll call and Commissioners answered roll call for attendance.

Chair Sirmans welcomed the visitors both virtually and in-person and thanked Don Splinter, Georgia Association of Educational (GAEL) for attending in-person.

V. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT

Matt Arthur reminded the Commission that it was 1 year ago that Governor Kemp made the announcement that we would be working from home (March, 2020). Due to budget cuts and the pandemic the decision was made to reduce our office space and give up our boardroom. The pandemic forced many boards including ours to quickly pivot to virtual models. Over time, we have all been able to find our footing, and now have solid participation and good

discussions on rules, Educator Ethics cases, and Educator Preparation program decisions. Moving forwarding, we would like to adopt a hybrid model with three in-person meetings, each with a virtual option, per year in September, January, and April. For the remaining 9 months, meetings will be virtual only. Commissioners do not have to worry about scheduling vacations in the summer as all summer meetings will be virtual. This model will allow us to continue to accomplish our core work during the 9 virtual meetings, while still affording opportunities for most of the special presentations and informational segments during the combined in-person and virtual meetings. This hybrid model allows us to maximize our time together and still accomplish the work, while protecting individuals' time and state dollars.
