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V. <u>EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT</u>

Executive Secretary Matt Arthur spoke briefly about the following:

- Senate budget meetings He had presented to the Senate and the meeting went well. We were being cut 14% and that has changed to 11%. The repercussions of the cuts will mean that our response time will be slower and work in general.
- We met with GBA regarding our space. We gave up the 4th floor boardroom and we our downsizing the 17th floor space.
- Met with the Office of Planning & Budget and they were pleased with quarterly highlights and appreciative of all of our work.

- He thanked Matt Arthur and the PSC staff for streamlining our process and cutting burdensome regulations. He said that he was proud that have done all of this in such a short time and that he proud to be a part of the team.
