12. STUDENT LOAN SUSPENSION / REINSTATEMENTS

The Commission reviewed the report, which indicated that there were 13 certificates suspended from April 12, 2007 through May 10, 2007. There were 7 certificates that had been reinstated because restitution is now being made on those student loans. There were 6 issues where notification had been received to suspend but releases were received prior to the actual suspension being implemented. Restitution is now being made on those student loans.
