10. <u>APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATION REPORT</u>

11. STUDENT LOAN SUSPENSION / REINSTATEMENTS

The Commission reviewed the report, which indicated that there were 14 certificates suspended from April 12, 2012 through May 10, 2012. There were 6 certificates that had been *reinstated* because restitution is now being made on those student loans. The Committee was also advised that there were 14 issues where notification had been received to suspend but releases were received prior to the actual suspension being implemented. Restitution is now being made on those student loans.
