I. WORK SESSION

- Angie Gant, Director of Program Approval, gave a presentation on Georgia's P-20 Collaboratives which included their vision, mission statement, and an update on their progress.
- Penney McRoy, Director of Educator Preparation, gave an update on Preparation Program Effectiveness Measures (PPEM). The goal of the PPEM is to improve student learning in Georgia through raising the quality of the teachers and leaders responsible for their education. The PPEM data for teacher preparation programs will be made available in July.
- Anne Marie Fenton presented the rules. The rules are effective one month after they are adopted. On March 14, 2019, the Commission initiated 19 certification rules and 12 educator preparation rules, which were brought to the Commission for their consideration of adopting. No public comment was received.
