The Educator Ethics Review Committee recommended to approve a no probable cause determination on 47 cases reflected on the *Applications for Certification Report*.

The Commission reviewed the *Review Hearing Extensions Report* concerning 1 hearing case. An Administrative Law Judge rendered an Initial Decision on the case referenced in the report. The report indicates Orders were issued.

12. STUDENT LOAN SUSPENSION / REINSTATEMENTS

The Commission reviewed the report, which indicated that there were 5 certificates *suspended* from September 13, 2007 through October 11, 2007. There were 3 certificates that had been *reinstated* because restitution is now being made on those student loans. There were 6 issues where notification had been received to suspend but releases were received prior to the actual suspension being implemented. Restitution is now being made on those student loans.

The Commission reviewed the report, which advised of no cases closed without an appeal for a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge. The report also advised that there were 2 cases closed without an appeal for a review hearing before the Commission.

The Commission rejected the recommendation made by the Administrative Law Judge to issue a Warning against the educator's certificate and to Monitor the educator's performance and conduct during the 2007-2008 school year. Based on a review of the complete record, and because the recommendation does not reflect the seriousness with which the Commission views the Respondent's violation of Standard 7 of the Code of Ethics for educators and because the recommendation is not consistent with similar cases, the Commission hereby Ordered that the Georgia educator certificate held by Demetrice C. Houston be Suspended for a period of one month. The suspension shall become effective October 26, 2007 and shall conclude November 26, 2007.
