Test Field Rows

Number Tested = Number of program completers who took the test within the appropriate five-year testing window. For content area tests, only program completers with reported certification field(s) appropriate for the test are included in "Number Tested." For program completers who took both Praxis and GACE tests, only GACE test results are reported, unless a program completer passed all the Praxis tests required but not the GACE tests in the category.

Number Passed = Number of program completers included in "Number Tested" who passed the test (not reported if "Number Tested" is fewer than ten).

Pass Rate = "Number Passed" divided by "Number Tested," expressed as a percentage.

Statewide Pass Rate = "Number Passed" for all institutions divided by "Number Tested" for all institutions, expressed as a percentage.

Aggregate Rows

Number Tested = Number of program completers who took at least one test in the category within the five-year testing window. For content area categories, this includes only those tests appropriate for a program completer's reported certification field(s). Completers are counted once for each test taken

that corresponds to the reported certification field(s). Therefore, the number in the "Aggregate Number Tested" column may be greater than the number of program completers for your institution.

Number Passed = Number of program completers included in "Number Tested" who passed all the tests they took that are required for their reported certification field. For program completers who took both Praxis and GACE tests, GACE test results supersede Praxis results, unless a program completer passed all the Praxis tests required but not the GACE tests in the category.

Pass Rate = "Number Passed" divided by "Number Tested," expressed as a percentage.

Statewide Pass Rate = "Number Passed" for all institutions divided by "Number Tested" for all institutions, expressed as a percentage.
