505-2-.171 SPECIAL EDUCATION PHYSICAL AND HEALTH DISABILITIES ENDORSEMENT

(1) To be eligible for the Special Education Physical and Health Disabilities Endorsement the applicant must hold a Clear Renewable Teaching Certificate in any field and complete other requirements outlined in PSC Rule [505-2-.12](#).

(2) The Special Education Physical and Health Disabilities Endorsement approved programs shall require completion of at least one Special Education Academic Content Concentration issued at a Cognitive Level of 4-8. (See PSC Rule [505-3-.67](#))

(3) In-Field Statement (See Rule [505-2-.26](#)). An individual with the Special Education Physical and Health Disabilities Endorsement is in-field to provide educational services for students with physical or health related disabilities in grades P-12. Educators are also in-field to provide educational services for special education preschool (Ages 3-5). Under the following conditions: The educator may work collaboratively with a content area teacher of record in all content subjects. To serve as a teacher of record, the educator may teach only the content subjects of their base certificate field(s) and the Special Education Academic Content Concentrations with designated Cognitive Levels identified on their certificate.
