505-2-.355 INSTRUCTIONAL SUPERVISION ENDORSEMENT

(1) General information on endorsements is found in PSC Rule [505-2-.12](#).

(2) To be eligible for the Instructional Supervision Endorsement the applicant shall:

(a) hold a master's or higher degree from a PSC-accepted accredited institution;

(b) hold a professional certificate in the teaching field in which the applicant plans to supervise OR a professional certificate in the service field of Speech and Language Pathology; and

(c) complete a state-approved program in the Instructional Supervision Endorsement. Information on the programs may be found on the PSC web site at www.gapsc.com.

(3) In-Field Statement (See Rule [505-2-.26](#)). An individual with the Instructional Supervision Endorsement is in-field to provide direction or supervision in the specific teaching or SLP service fields held. The Instructional Supervision Endorsement is appropriate for assistant principals when the assistant principal's assignment is instructional supervision for a major portion of the day.
