V. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT

Matt Arthur reported the following:

<u>Legislative Update - It has been a good session.</u> We have a good rapport with legislators and we are pleased when they reach out to us regarding new legislation. Once Governor Kemp signs legislation, I will let you know if there is any impact on us and if we need any rule changes.

<u>Ethics Symposium - I</u> am pleased to report that we had over 210 register for the Ethics Symposium. The theme was *Prevention and Correction: Fostering Professional Practice* and the audience included school

administrators, school district personnel (e.g., superintendents, HR directors, certification officials, PL directors, principals), and educator preparation provider (EPP) deans/chairs, program directors, and faculty. I want to thank Chair Brian Sirmans, Kedrione, Harris, Carol Williams, and Dr. Franklin Perry for joining us for this day and a half of learning. We have received very strong, positive feedback from attendees and look forward to hopefully hosting another ethics symposium in Fall 2024. This symposium is only one of many initiatives of ours to work collaboratively with districts, schools, EPPs, and others toward the goal of fostering an intentional focus on ethics to help educators avoid missteps.
