- This form is required when an applicant for Georgia certification is requesting initial certification or a new certificate field based upon completion of an approved educator preparation program. When applying to upgrade the level of current certification fields (no new field added), this form is not required.
- Documents verifying completion of the approved program and applicable special Georgia requirements must be submitted as part of the application package.
- It is the responsibility of the applicant to have this form completed by the authorized certification official before submitting it to the GaPSC.
