#### I. WORK SESSION

- 1. Rules Anne Marie Fentonspoke briefly about the rules for consideration of initiation at the March Commission meeting.
  - David Hill previewed **505-3-.60** Alternative Preparation for Educational Leadership Program, which will come before the Commission as a new rule. After discussion, Kelly Henson suggested the rule not move forward for initiation at the March meeting due to the points and questions raised during discussion. David Hill will provide another preview at the March Commission Work Session for possible initiation in July.
  - Bobbi Ford previewed **505-3-.26 Middle Grades Education**, for consideration to rescind and a new rule initiated in its place. The purpose of this revision is to align the rule to current reading and science standards.
  - Kelli Young previewed the following rules:
    - a) **505-2-.44 Georgia Educator Assessment Rule,** for consideration as a new rule to outline testing requirements for Georgia certification
    - b) **505-2-.43 Educational Interpreter Rule,** for consideration as a new rule developed to establish an Educational Interpreter License
    - c) **505-2-.25 Add a Field to an Existing Certificate,** for consideration to amend to limit the fields that be added to a clear renewable teaching certificate via testing.
    - d) **505-2-.02** Classification Category, Title, Type, Field, Level, for consideration to amend due to the new Educational Interpreter Rule and to refine the rule language.
- 2. Dr. Cyndy Stephens gave a powerpoint rpesentation on the Educator Workforce Recruitment and Development initiatives.

- 3. Executive Secretary Report Kelly Henson spoke briefly about House Bill 245. This bill has been proposed by Representative Tommy Benton. This bill would allow enrollment by an educator in a leadership preparation program or allow the educator to pursue a leadership degree at any time regardless as to whether he or she is currently serving in a leadership position or recommended or sponsored by a local board of education for a leadership preparation program. Chariman Coleman will let us know if it goes to the committee.
- 4. Commission Chair Report
  - Chair Elkins congratulated Commissioner Julia Bernath on the birth of her new Grandson, Hudson.
  - Chair Elkins spoke briefly about President Obama's State of the Union Address. The President called for major changes to the criteria accreditors use to evaluate colleges, asking Congress to either require accreditors to take college prices and educational value into account or to create an alternative system based on performance and results. He also visited a pre-kindergarten classroom at the College Heights Early Childhood Learning Center in Decatur, Georgia on February 14, 2013 regarding his call for investments in high-quality early childhood education programs.
  - She congratulated Dr. David Hill on his article in the PageOne magazine titled "What an Educator Should Know and Consider When Making Decisions About For-Profit Educator Preparation Programs."
