V. <u>EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT</u>

Our Ethics Symposium will be held on March 26 & 27 in Macon at Middle Georgia State University. This collaborative symposium will feature keynote and plenary presenters, panel presentations, and multiple concurrent breakout sessions focused on a range of topics centered on prevention and correction of educator missteps.
