

## **Summary of Proposed Changes to GaPSC Educator Preparation Rules**

January 11, 2018 Initiation

Public Comment Period: January 29, 2018 through February 27, 2018

At its January 11, 2018, meeting, the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC) initiated the rulemaking process for the Educator Preparation rule listed below. 505-302	EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROVIDER ANNUAL REPORTING AND EVALUATION	A number of revisions are proposed to Rule 505-302 EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROVIDER ANNUAL REPORTING AND EVALUATION. There are revisions to PPEM components (for Educational Leadership programs) and revisions to weightings for both teacher and leader preparation program measures (see pages 5-8). The amended rule deletes language related to two passing scores (Induction and Professional) on the GACE Content Assessment (p. 6) and clarifies the designation of programs and EPPs in four performance levels (p. 8). Other minor changes appear throughout the rule for clarification purposes. These revisions reflect feedback from the PPEM Advisory Council, comprised of representatives of GaPSC EPPs at public and private institutions, and GaTAPP providers.
