Discussion:

It is proposed that GaPSC Rule 505-2-.102 READING SPECIALIST, dated January 15, 2016, be AMENDED to change the field name of Early Childhood Education P-5 to Elementary Education P-5.

- 1. Early Childhood Education Elementary Education Certificate, for grades P-5;
- 2. Middle Grades Reading Certificate, for grades 4-8;
- 3. Reading Endorsement, for the grade levels of the base certificate(s).
