- 1. Hold a level four (4) or higher renewable professional certificate in one of the following fields: Early Childhood Education Elementary Education; Special Education General Curriculum/ECE Elementary Education; Middle Grades Language Arts; Middle Grades Math; or Special Education General Curriculum with a language arts and/or mathematics concentration; and
 - 2. Complete other requirements outlined in GaPSC Rule 505-2-.14 ENDORSEMENTS.
- (b) To be eligible for the Supplemental Induction Intervention Specialist Endorsement, the applicant must:
- 1. Hold a level four (4) or higher Induction certificate in one of the following fields: Early Childhood Education Elementary Education; Special Education General Curriculum/ECE Elementary Education; Middle Grades Language Arts; Middle Grades Math; or General Curriculum with a language arts and/or mathematics concentration; and
 - 2. Complete other requirements outlined in GaPSC Rule 505-2-.14 ENDORSEMENTS.
- (2) In-Field Statement (See GaPSC Rule 505-2-.40 IN-FIELD ASSIGNMENT). An individual with the Intervention Specialist Endorsement has strengthened and enhanced competency levels for teaching students in early intervention programs who are at risk of not reaching or maintaining academic grade level in the base certificate(s) field(s).
