

Summary of Proposed Changes to GaPSC Educator Ethics Rules

July 11, 2019 Initiation

Public Comment Period: July 29, 2019 – August 27, 2019

At its July 11, 2019, meeting, the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC) initiated the rulemaking process for the Educator Ethics rules listed below. Rule #	Rule Name	Summary of Rules Action
505-601	The Code of Ethics for Educators	The proposed revisions to Georgia's Code of Ethics for Educators clarifies a definition, identifies "under the influence" indicators, and amends language in the grounds that shall be considered cause for disciplinary action.
505-605	Review of Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge	The proposed rule revision aligns the code section quoted within the rule to reflect the revised code section in the Official Code of Georgia, and clarifies when the Administrative Law Judge's order becomes effective.
