

Summary of Proposed Changes to GaPSC Educator Preparation Rules

July 8, 2021 Initiation

Public Comment Period: July 26, 2021, through August 24, 2021

Rule #	Rule Name	Summary of Rules Action
505-306	Pedagogy-Only Program	Amendments proposed to Rule 505-306 include clarification of coursework eligible for use as evidence of content expertise and the exclusion of the new field of Reading Education (T).
505-327	Mathematics Education Program	Amendments are proposed to Rule 505-327 to update the program content standards.
505-392	K-5 Mathematics Endorsement Program	Amendments proposed to Rule 505-392 include updates to the program content standards and the July 1, 2022, sunset of the process for converting the Early Childhood Education Mathematics Endorsement to the K-5 Mathematics Endorsement.
