

Summary of Proposed Changes to GaPSC Educator Preparation Rules

March 30, 2022, Initiation

Also included are educator preparation provider (EPP) reporting deadlines for entering newly enrolled candidates.
505-3.05	Georgia Teacher Academy For Preparation And Pedagogy (GaTAPP)	Proposed amendments will remove the program admission requirements of a minimum GPA of 2.5 and a passing score on the Program Admission Assessment.
