505-224 505-234	Special Georgia Requirements Add a Field	These rules are being amended to include a change in testing providers resulting in new assessment titles, the addition of a new state-required literacy assessments in compliance with The Georgia Early Literacy Act (HB 538) of 2023, removal of the test-in option for the fields of Middle Grades Reading 4-8 and Reading P-12 and changes to both organize format and include information for clarity and consistency.
505-236	Renewal Requirements	This rule is being amended to include accepting continuing education courses accredited by the International Dyslexia Association (IDA), as IDA training is accepted by the Georgia Department of Education to satisfy literacy training requirements of the Georgia Early Literacy Act (HB 538) of 2023.
