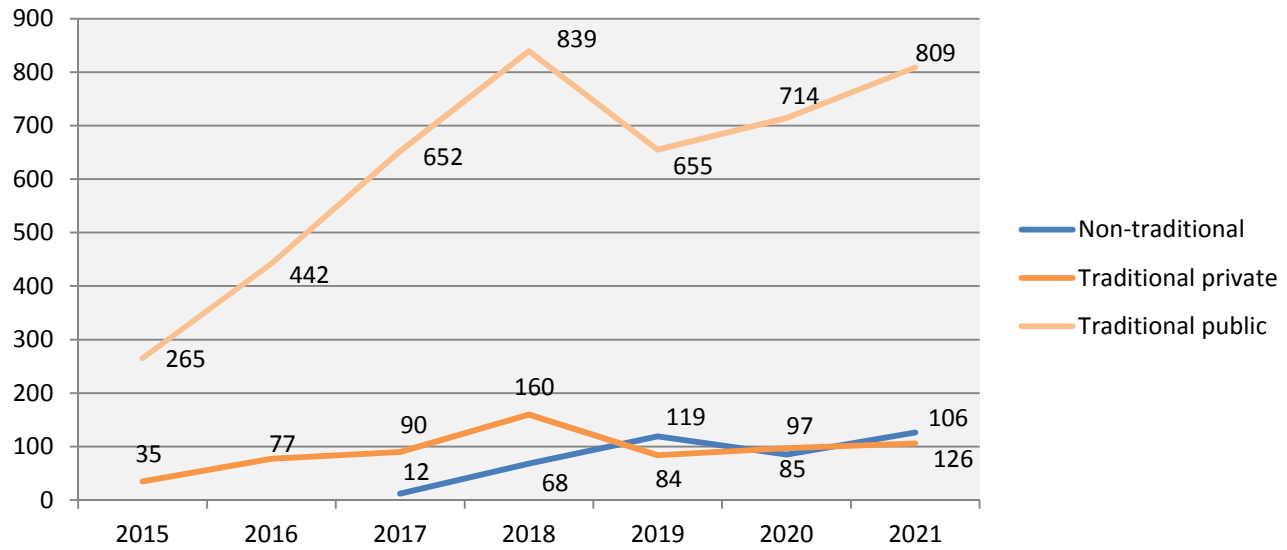

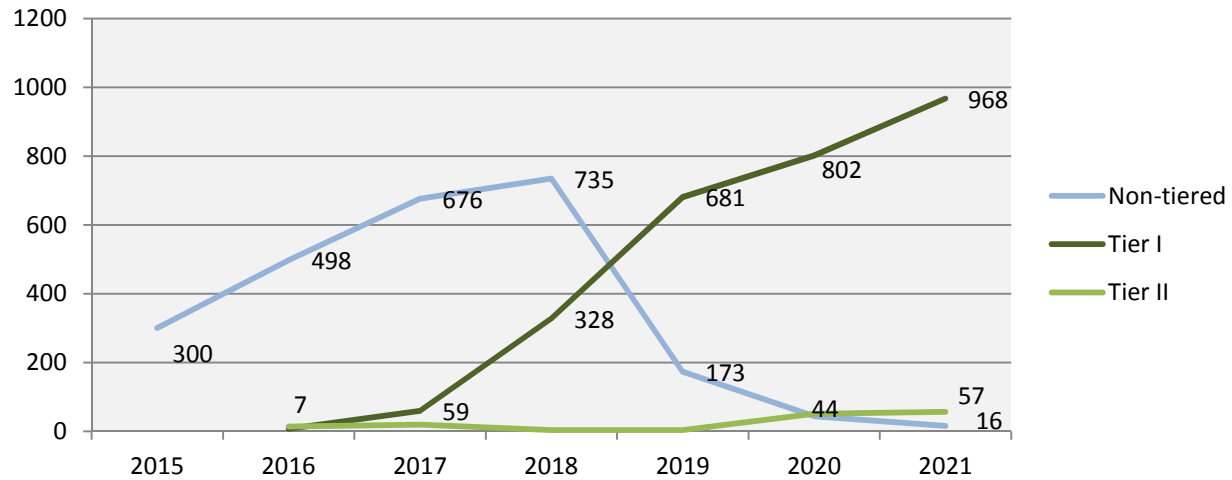

## Trend in Leadership Program Completers by Provider Type

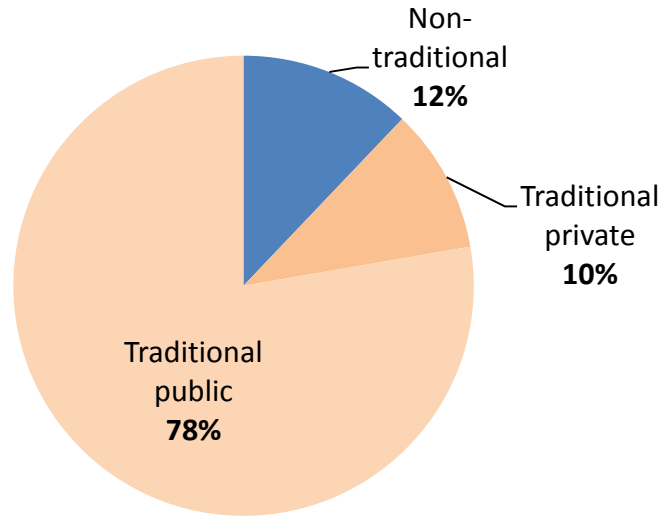


## Trend in Leadership Program Completers by Tier

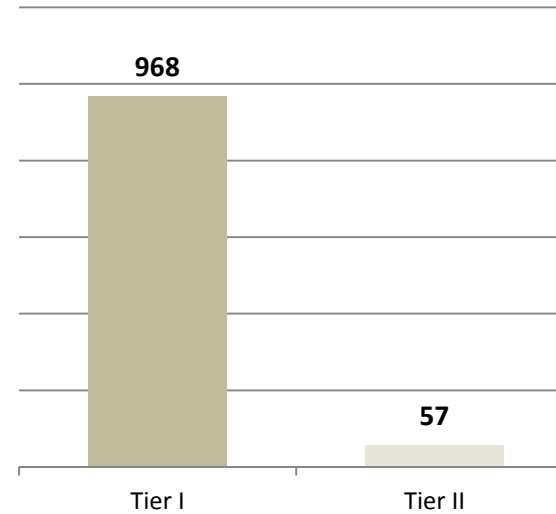

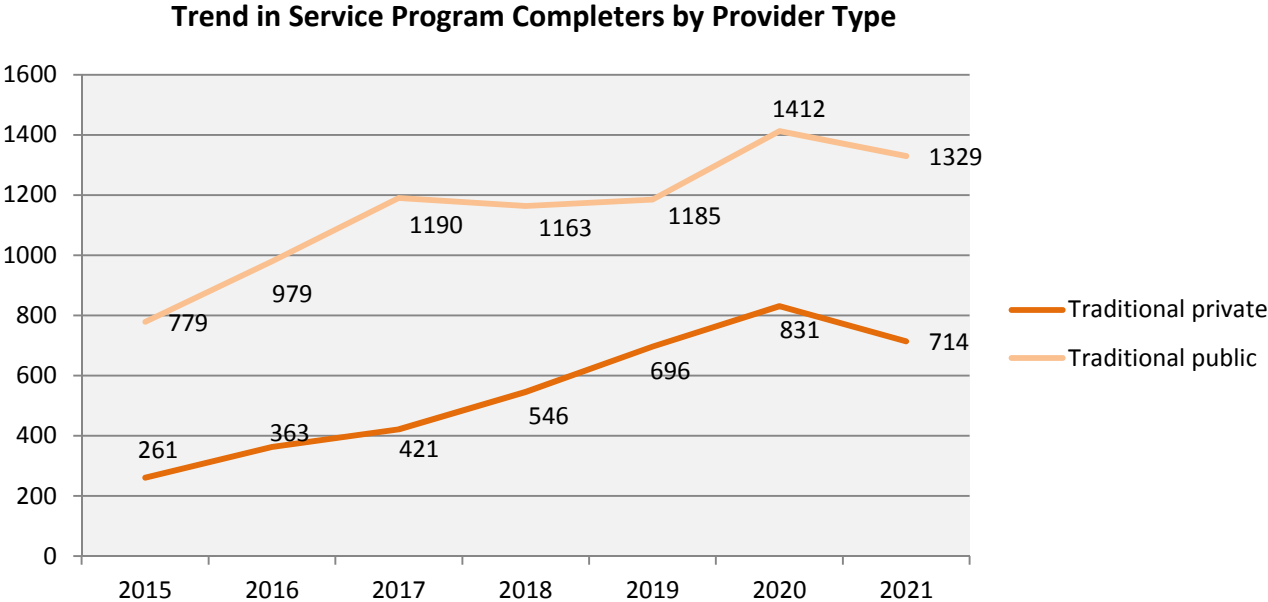

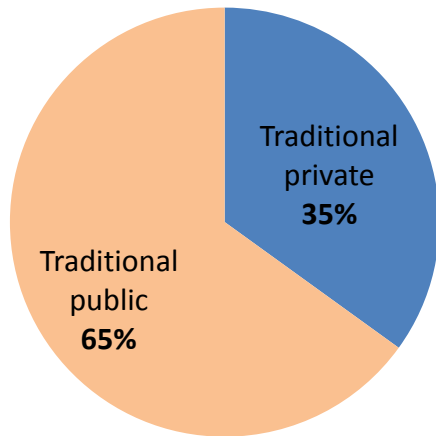
