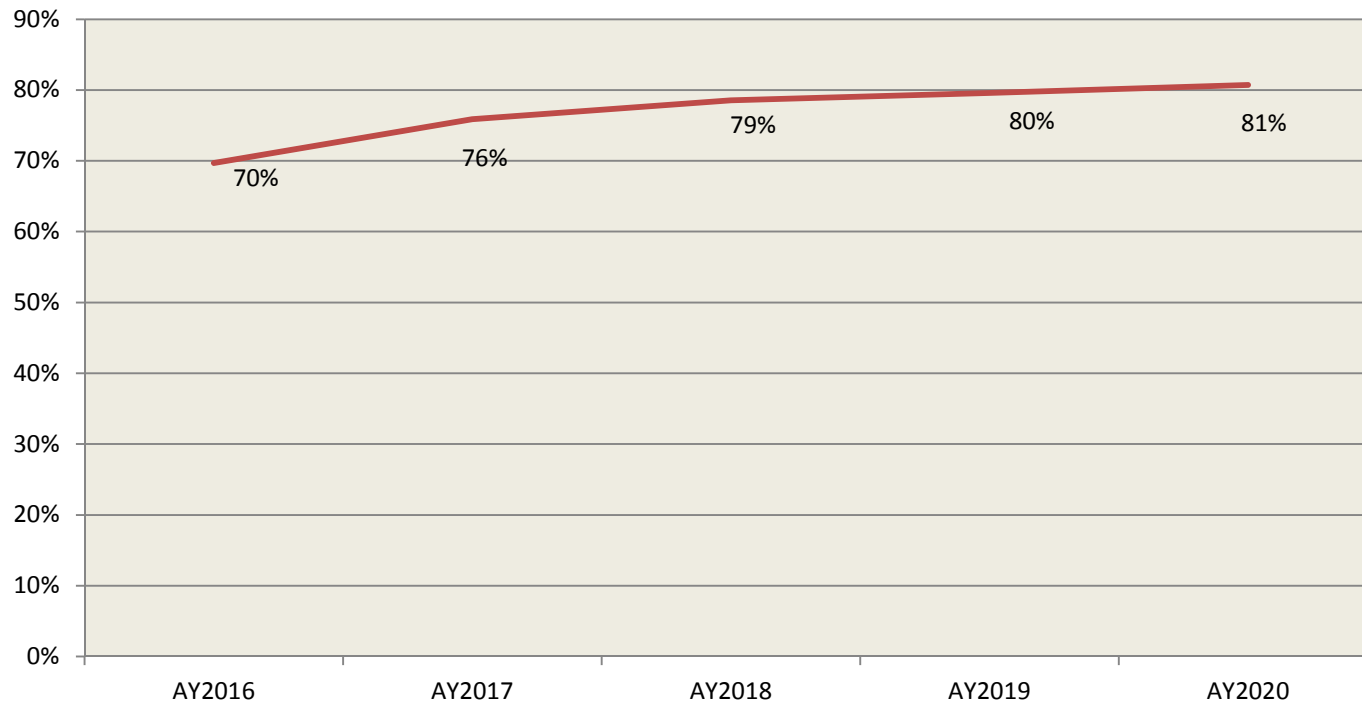


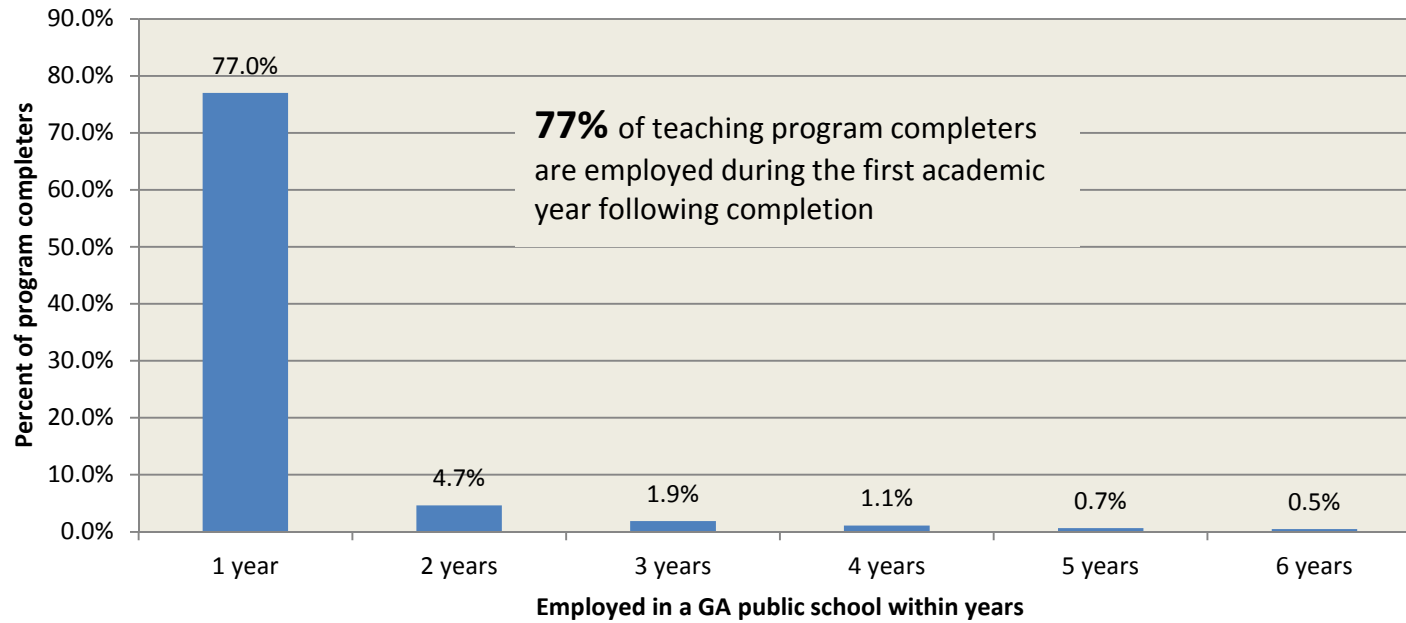

Public school employment of teachers in first year following program completion



























































Distance in time until employed in a GA public school following completion



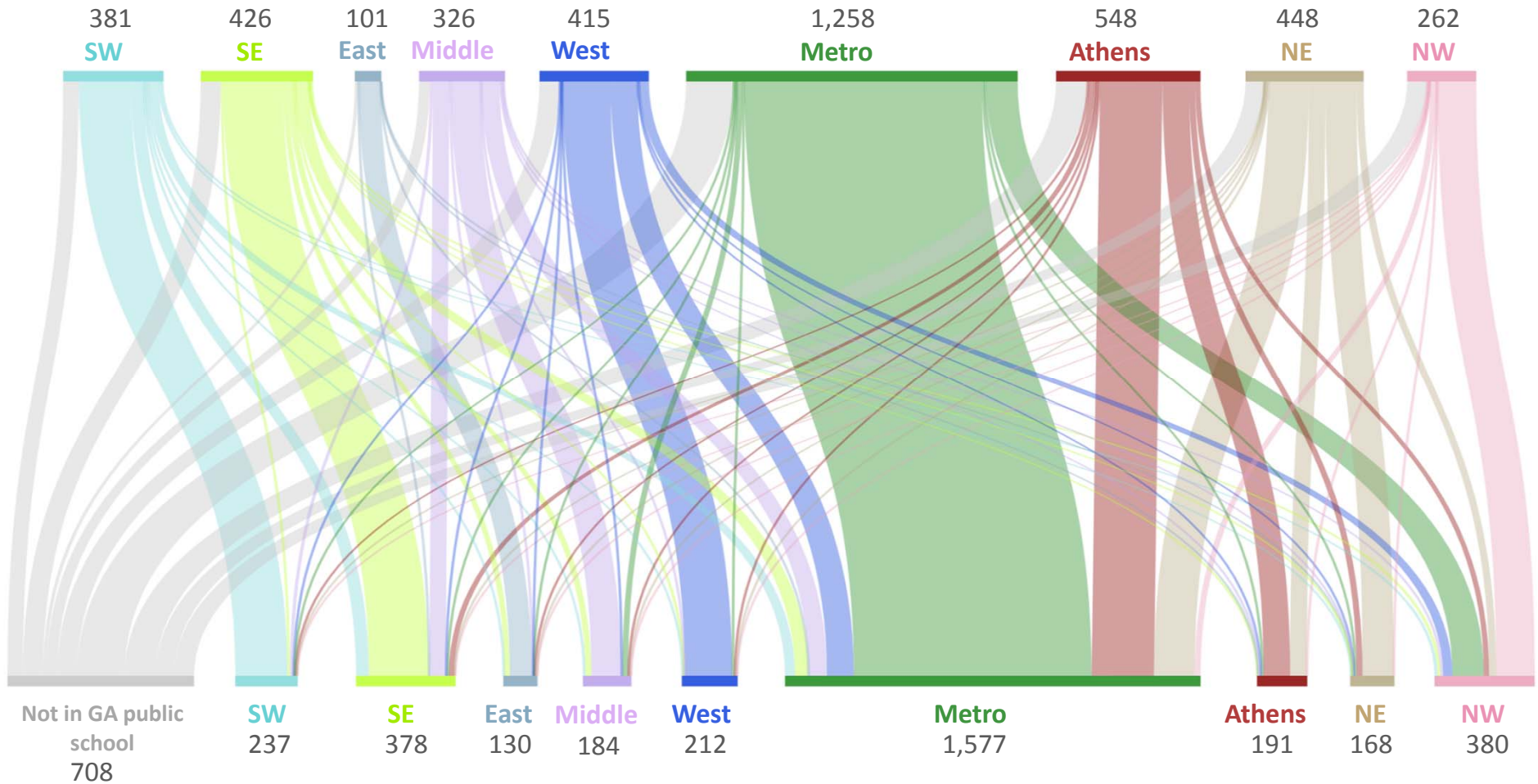

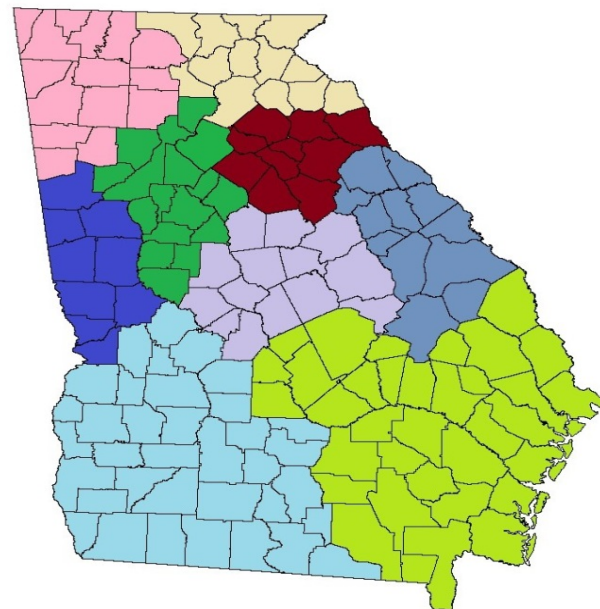
