

What is CMS?

- O Contact Management System (CMS) is a webbased system stored in our secure portal and used to maintain contact information for GaPSCapproved EPPs and other stakeholders
- CMS was designed to place the responsibility for maintaining current contact information with the EPPs and organizations with whom we communicate
- O Staff will have the ability to retrieve contact information and e-mail directly



Who Enters the Data?

Each EPP, LEA, RESA, and Private Education Agency has identified two individuals who will be responsible for the initial entry and regular updates for key EPP personnel; these Contact Administrators are now able to enter contact data in CMS

 Contact Administrators are credentialed and permitted access to the system through <u>GAPSC.org</u>



Update Indications!

- Administrative Assistant will send periodic email reminders to prompt system reviews and updates
- Monitors (CMS) and advises IT staff of system improvements and arising issues

In order for a candidate to complete field experiences (including clinical practice/student teaching) in Georgia, the candidate must be entered into our data system, the Traditional Program Management System (TPMS). The process begins with the completion of the attached spreadsheet. You will need to tell us the program(s) you want us to include in our system for your university. By submitting the spreadsheet, you are asserting that the program is state approved in the home state of the university. For validation purposes, please include in your e-mail the link to the state approval agency's website that lists your EPP's approved programs.

The Pre-Service certificate is **not** a professional educator certificate. It allows the holder to participate in supervised field experience, clinical practice, student teaching, or residency work in Georgia schools.





- Standardize criminal background check process across the state for Pre-Service teachers; eliminating those not eligible/suited for profession
- Assists Pre-Service educators in understanding the Georgia Educator Code of Ethics as well has hold them accountable under the code of ethics





- EPP input candidate's information in TPMS
- Candidate claims program in MyPSC
- Candidate takes Ethics-Test Code 360
- Candidate applies for Pre-Service certificate via MyPSC account
- VLP submitted with application request





- Valid for 5 years
- Invalidated upon:
 - Program Completion
 - Withdrawal, transfer, or removed from program.






Other Options for Certificate

- A student can be issued Provisional or Waiver after Pre-Service is issued
 - Pre-Service certificate will be made obsolete

Clinical practice for all fields must occur in

- regionally accredited public schools,
- charter schools approved by the Georgia State Charter School Commission,
- charter schools approved by the Georgia Department of Education,
- out-of-state charter schools approved by the state's charter schools commission or department of education,
- private schools accredited by a GaPSC-accepted accreditor,
 Department of Defense schools, or
- in international settings meeting accreditation criteria specified in GaPSC Rule505-2-.31 <u>GAPSC ACCEPTED ACCREDITATION</u>; VALIDATION OF NON-ACCREDITED DEGREES"

Reminders: Mentor Teachers

- should have three years of experience
- must be certified in the field the candidate is seeking
- 500 hours is the minimum number of clinical hours. (A semester is 600 hours, but we are anticipating holidays, weather days, etc.)
- If a candidate completes clinical practice in Georgia, they are no longer eligible for seeking certification through reciprocity.





Accreditation:

To be accepted for certification purposes in Georgia, the college/university must have held accreditation by a GaPSC-accepted accrediting agency at the time the degree was awarded. The GaPSC accepts colleges/universities recognized by The Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) (www.chea.org) or the U.S. Department of Education (USDOE) (www.ed.gov).

State-Approved:

The educator preparation program must have been approved by the state approval authority that approves teacher preparation programs in the state in which the college/university is administratively based and it must lead to professional certification in that state.

HOW TO CLAIM PROGRAM?



Program

Enrollees in traditional educator preparation programs cannot take a GACE content assessment until made eligible by their program provider. Educator preparation program providers report your enrollment, and you must claim your enrollment you were made eligible to test. Eligibility to take a GACE assessment depends on many factors which vary from provider to provider.















Checking Status of Pre-Service

GCIC/ ETHICS PHASE





- Once Pre-Service documents are verified, a Georgia Crime Information Center (GCIC) criminal record check is conducted
- If candidate responded "No" to all Personal Affirmation questions on application and the criminal record check does not contradict those answers, the Pre-Service Certificate is issued through the candidates MyPSC account
- If candidates responded "Yes" to any Personal Affirmation questions, OR the answers are not consistent with the report generated by GaPSC, an ethics investigation is conducted. The Commission reviews the results and issues one of the following decisions:
 - Candidate is cleared and Pre-Service Certificate is issued
 - Candidate is given a warning and Pre-Service Certificate is issued
 - Candidate is given a reprimand and the Pre-Service Certificate is issued
 - Candidate is denied the Pre-Service Certificate

If a Pre-Service Certificate holder violates the Code of Ethics, must the violation be reported to GaPSC?

YES. Pre-Service Certificate holders are certified individuals, and they are expected to uphold the Code of Ethics. Both program providers and school districts are equally responsible for reporting suspected violations of the Code of Ethics to GaPSC. All educators are mandated reporters and are required to report alleged misconduct. For the educator,
