

Due Diligence

Black's Law Dictionary, 12th ed. 2024

- 1. The diligence reasonably expected from, and ordinarily exercised by, a person who seeks to satisfy a legal requirement or to discharge an obligation. Also termed reasonable diligence; common diligence.
- Corporations & securities. A prospective buyer's or broker's investigation and analysis of a target company, a piece of property, or a newly issued security. • A failure to exercise due diligence may sometimes result in liability, as when a broker recommends a security without first investigating it adequately.

Primary vs. Secondary Sources

- 1. Primary sources are the origin point for the biographical information you are seeking to verify. The court that issued a certified copy of a criminal case's disposition is a primary source. A court would consider this to be the best evidence.
- 2. Secondary sources are one or more steps removed. A copy of an uncertified criminal case disposition obtained from an applicant or a third party, such as a former employer, would be a secondary source. Secondary sources are good for developing suspicion that may justify spending additional time to seek evidence from a primary source.





You Have Suspicion - Now What?

If you develop suspicion that an applicant has submitted an altered or fictitious document, your first step should be to seek clarification from the applicant. The applicant may be able to explain the issue, and may subsequently be able to provide consent to obtain the information from a primary source. The applicant could also decide to withdraw his/her application when confronted with evidence.

If you develop enough suspicion to believe an ethical violation has occurred, the applicant should be reported to the PSC, or law enforcement if a crime has been committed.
