

EPP Readiness Framework:

Demonstrating Capacity to Undergo a Review

Introduction/Guidance

Thank you for your interest in becoming an approved Educator Preparation Provider in Georgia. Please note the following information concerning the process.

- Before the Educator Preparation Provider (EPP) Readiness Framework may be submitted, the EPP must meet all .01 rule requirements.
- Once the Framework has been submitted, it will be reviewed by the GaPSC Liaison assigned to the EPP and will be reviewed by at least two other GaPSC Liaisons.
- The GaPSC Liaison assigned to the EPP will provide information concerning the approval of the Readiness Framework within 45 days of submission.
- The EPP must submit the *Intent to Seek GaPSC Approval Form and Date Preference Form (ISA Form)* within one year of receiving approval of the Readiness Framework.
- Once the ISA form has been received, the GaPSC Liaison will begin the process of facilitating the review, including creating PRS-II (the electronic format for submitting information), providing technical assistance for the review, and establishing timelines.
- No candidates may be enrolled for programs until both the EPP and the programs have been officially approved by the Commission.
