(a) In addition, the following certificates and endorsements are also considered in-field to teach Reading at the designated grade levels:

1. Elementary Education Certificate, for grades P-5;
2. Middle Grades Reading Certificate, for grades 4-8;
3. Reading Endorsement, for the grade levels of the base certificate(s).
